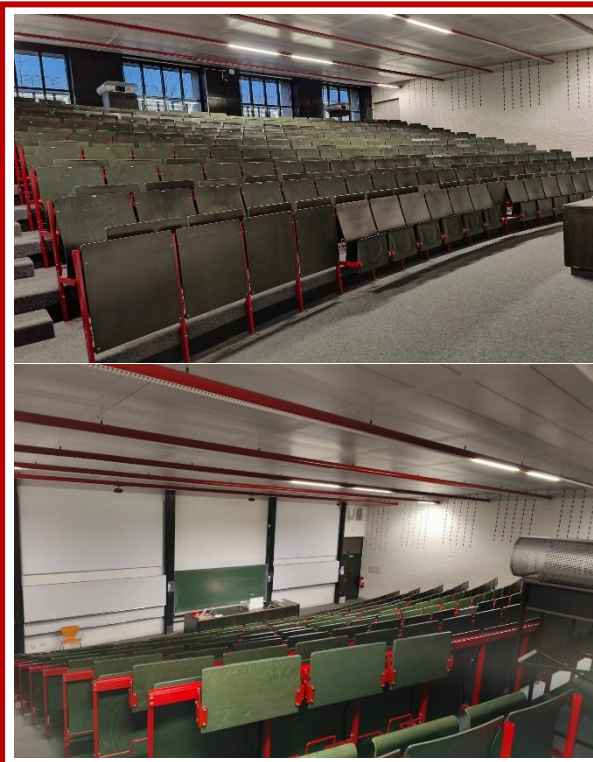

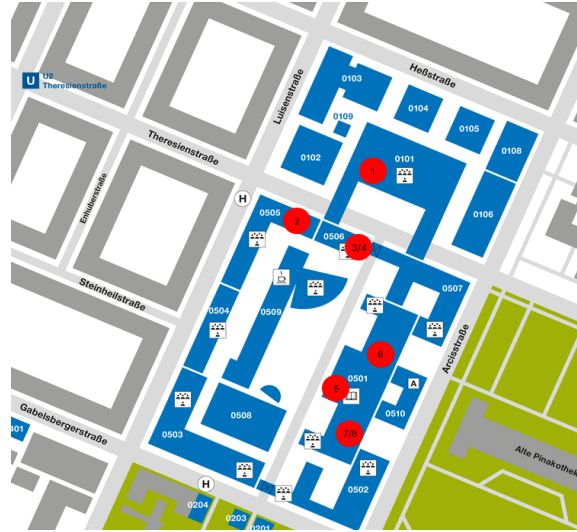
VENUE MAP
